The author of “The Mystery of the Second Wound” should be listed as James Keddie, Sr.

James Keddie, Sr. (1883-1942), co-founder (in 1940) of the Speckled Band of Boston, the first scion society based outside New York, was an early Sherlockian scholar who corresponded frequently with Morley, Starrett, Smith, and others. Several of his papers on Holmes appeared in “respectable” publications, as well as Starrett’s *221B: Essays in Sherlock Holmes*. Here, he tackles one of the great conundrums of Sherlockiana, Watson’s wound(s). The paper was delivered at the 1942 Irregulars Dinner by his son James, Jr. (invested in 1945).
